Narrow two lane road with no shoulder Use caution when crossing or cycling
- Bosley Ave, Between Joppa and York**
Narrow two lane road with no shoulder Use caution when crossing or cycling

PEDESTRIAN FRIENDLY

- Bridge over Towsontown Blvd**
Towson University pedestrian bridge.
- Glen Woods**
A wooded area of campus that also functions as a rope course.
- Annual Get Ready! Get Set! Get Fit! 5K Run/Walk- 1M Walk**
A yearly fitness walk around the university track.
- Trees of Towson Walking Tour**
A walk around campus that includes all the trees found in Maryland.
- Walkable Towson**
Master plan to make Towson more pedestrian friendly.
- Rogers Forge on Stevenson Ln**
Pedestrian-friendly street that has crossing guards.
- Annual Towsontown Spring Festival**
A yearly festival when the streets are shut down for local food and vendors.
- Allegheny Ave**
A pedestrian-friendly street in the downtown area with many shops and restaurants.

MTA BUS AND LIGHT RAIL
MTA Bus and Light Rail schedules, maps, pricing, times, and all other information can be found at www.mta.com. Prices for one-way travel on MTA Buses are \$1.60, \$3.20 for round trip, and \$3.50 for a day pass which allows travel on any MTA Bus and Light Rail for day of purchase.

TOWSON ON/OFF CAMPUS SHUTTLE

WALKABLE TOWSON

This plan was designed to improve the streetscapes of Towson and to make the area more pedestrian friendly. The changes include widening the sidewalks, improving the traffic circle, and making the street and building facades more attractive. Other changes will be adding new signs, trees for shade, and combining residential, retail, and office buildings in one area to enhance street activity. The goal of this plan is to make Towson a stimulating and safe pedestrian environment.

WALKABLE TOWSON BICYCLE PLAN

The Bicycle Plan will make much needed improvements to bike travel in the Towson area. Currently many roads around Towson are hazardous to attempt to ride along with traffic because of a lack of bicycle path lanes. With this proposed plan, there will be many more designated bicycle lanes, shared use pathways, and signs showing that the roadway is to be shared. The bicycle plan includes the uptown Towson area and extends down to Towson University, easing commutes for students bicycling to the university.

ICON GUIDE

-  **BICYCLE SITE**
Good places to buy, borrow, repair or rent bicycles, work bikes and other bike-friendly services and sites.
-  **LIGHT RAIL**
Light rail line station or stop. Surface transportation by eco-efficient light rail runs in these areas.
-  **PEDESTRIAN FRIENDLY**
Areas which favor walking over automobiles, such as pedestrian malls, plazas and traffic calmed areas that limit or restrict car traffic.
-  **TRAFFIC HAZARD**
Indicates places where motorized traffic is especially heavy, noisy, polluting and dangerous to pedestrians, bicyclists and other people.
-  **BICYCLE PARKING**
Recommended area for secure storage or locking of bicycles with adequate lighting and bike racks at a transit station, workplace, on campus, or other area.
-  **PUBLIC/MASS TRANSPORTATION**
Mass transit station or subway or bus stop.
-  **BICYCLE PATH**
Includes designated and recommended bicycle paths or lanes.

WALKING AND BIKING ROUTES

These routes refer to the safest commute from the most popular Towson communities to the Towson University campus.

 - ↓ Head south on Knollwood Rd
 - Turn right on Garden Rd
 - Turn right on Aigburth Rd
 - Cross York Rd to campus
- From Towson Woods Apartments, Kenilworth at Charles, and The Colony at Kenilworth**
 - Turn left on Kenilworth Dr towards Charles St
 - Turn left on Charles St
 - ↑ Continue straight on Charles St until the intersection with Towsontown Blvd
 - Turn left onto Towsontown Blvd
 - Turn right on Osler Rd
 - Turn left into campus
- From Fellowship Court**
 - Turn right on Hillen Rd
 - Continue on Burke Ave
 - Cross York Rd to campus
- From Fairways At Towson**
 - ↓ Turn left on Colbury Rd
 - ↓ Turn left on Goucher Blvd
 - ↓ Bear left on Hillen Rd
 - ↓ Continue on Burke Ave
 - Cross York Rd to campus

- From Donnybrook Apartments**

 - Continue on Burke Ave
 - Cross York Rd to campus

 - ↓ Turn left on Colbury Rd
 - ↓ Turn left on Goucher Blvd
 - ↓ Bear left on Hillen Rd
 - ↓ Continue on Burke Ave
 - Cross York Rd to campus
