



Report on Activities of PETA HIJAU (Green Map Indonesia) in 2008

2. Website of Peta Hijau (<http://greenmap.or.id>) administered throughout the year.
 3. Mailing List of Peta Hijau (greenmapindonesia@yahoogroups.com) administered throughout the year, with 179 members until 28 December 2008, and with average number of message 18.83 each month.
 4. Mailing List of Peta Hijau Yogyakarta (greenmapper_jogja@yahoogroups.co) administered throughout the year, with 225 members until 28 December 2008 and with average number of message 51.16 each month.
 5. Two green map projects have been registered in the International Secretariat of Green Map: Peta Hijau Makassar (Makassar Green Map; September 2008, by Meta Sekar P. A.) and Peta Hijau Jakarta (Jakarta Green Map; August 2008, by Shanty S. and Nirwono Yoga).
 6. To follow up green map workshop in Medan (28-29 February 2008), Medan Green Map project has begun in North Sumatera since February 2008, coordinated by Esther Risma Purba.
 7. To follow up green map workshop in Solo (19 August 2008), Green Map of Sebelas Maret University in Solo, Central Java, has begun since August 2008, initiated by Rully Kusumaningdyah.
 8. Activity of green map making in Ternate, North Maluku, has begun since October 2008, initiated by Arlinah Madjid and Nadrah. It is a follow up of green map workshop held in Makassar held in September 13-14 2008.
 9. Activity of green map making in Borobudur Village, Magelang, Central Java, has begun since December 2008, initiated by Mr. Maladi (Head of the Village) and Jack Priyana (a local community figure). It is a follow up of green map workshop held in December 13 – 14, 2008.
 10. Information and communication networks have been made with diverse organizations that are potential to implement Green Map and/or to support activities of green map making in their respective areas.

3. Factors supporting the activities:

1. Despite the long distance, the coordination of Peta Hijau national network could be quite optimally managed through online communication.
2. Direct support from the International Secretariat of Green Map in New York, US, by intensively communicating the activities and trusting Peta Hijau (Green Map Indonesia) to independently manage the project registration fund for the national networks' activities.
3. With online resource system (<http://greenmap.org>) and shared green map system (<http://opengreenmap.org>), Green Map System supports the improvement of knowledge and capacity to manage the national network of Peta Hijau.
4. Communication with many activists in networks of diverse organizations, either government, non government or academic, have been able to develop networks to support Peta Hijau's activities at the national level and at local level of Yogyakarta.

4. Factors impeding the activities:



1. The management team of Peta Hijau has not yet had socialization media in the form of print media that can be disseminated to all members of the national network.
2. Peta Hijau has not optimally made use of networking partner with mass media for the publicity of the national network of Peta Hijau.
3. Due to limited fund, Peta Hijau has not been able to fully give financial support to all activities of Peta Hijau at national level.
4. Because Peta Hijau is not a corporate body, it has not been able to optimally take practical steps to raise fun.
5. Because the coordination of local management of Yogyakarta was not optimal, dual role should be played by national management of Peta Hijau, influencing on the degree of quality of attention and handling of managerial affairs at national level.
6. Peta Hijau has not been able to build a distribution and marketing system for the products of the network to the public.

5. Solutions over the obstacles and recommendation:

1. To improve and build management team that is able to effectively manage all activities both at national and at local (Yogyakarta) levels.
2. To obtain more support from international secretariat of Green Map and international network of Green Map to develop activities and to strengthen the national network of Peta Hijau.
3. To hold a national meeting of Peta Hijau in mid of 2009 to formulate strategic plan for Peta Hijau Indonesia in several years ahead.
4. To widen the network with more organizations and people, both from home and abroad, to develop activities and strengthen the national network of Peta Hijau.
