🌳-01 Loess walls mark the boundaries of the plateau of Parndorf. You can watch a variety of birds here, such as the sand martin and the bee eater, but also many amphibians and insects.

🌳-02 "Natural Monument Sand Martin" represents the only natural monument of Neusiedl am See. d5

👁️-01 Enjoy the view over the town of Neusiedl from the top of Calvary Hill. d8-e8; 👁️-02 Ruins of Tabor with a spectacular view, the Leitha Mountains and the Alps are visible in the distance. d6

🌊 Waterfront and Mole West allow you to view spectacular sunsets from here. h6

Did you know that...?

... Lake Neusiedl is located at the boundaries of five distinct landscapes?

In the west, the lake is surrounded by mountains, i.e. the spurs of the Eastern Alps, the Ruster Höhenzug, and the Leitha Mountains (Leithagebirge). To the north, the gravel plateau of Parndorf stretches for some 200 km². On each side of the border between Austria and Hungary, Lake Neusiedl is complemented by characteristic wetlands, Hanság and Fertő Niche (Seewinkel). This part of the region is characterised by the so called „Lacken“, up to 80 small, shallow pools of no more than 70 centimetres depth as well as by remnant salt meadows.



... temperatures can range from - 25°C to 40°C ?

The Pannonian climate dominating weather events in the region implies hot and dry summer months, with more than 60 days with temperatures ranging above 25°C. Yet, the Pannonian climate is also responsible for cold winters resulting in some 90 frost days, annually.

... local flora and fauna harbor an outstanding variety of rare and endangered species?

Lake Neusiedl is embedded in several global networks of protected areas.

- * Biosphere Reserve (UNESCO Man and the Biosphere Programme, 1977)

... Indigo is among the oldest dyes?

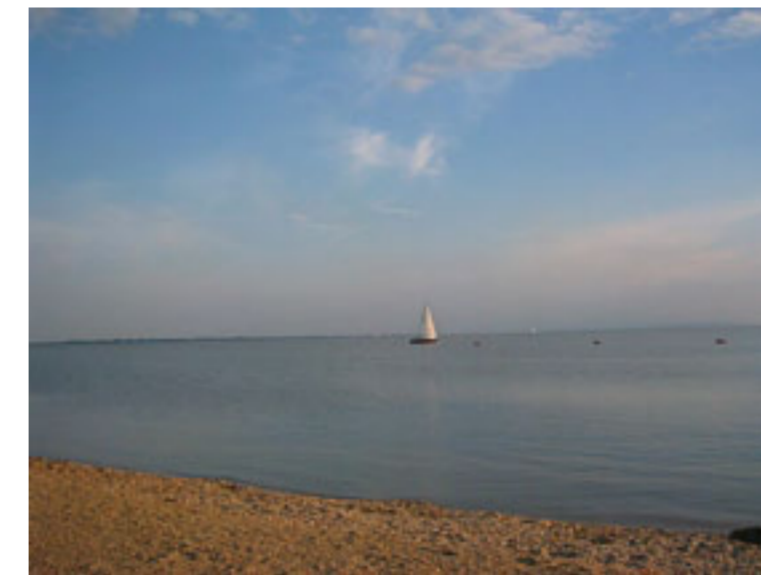
The socioeconomic initiative "Koryphäen" (©, ♻️), a long-term project aimed at the employment and education of women, was introduced in 1995. Working conditions within the initiative are adapted to the personal situation and individual needs of the women employed. Tailoring services and the second hand shop in the centre of Neusiedl am See (Hauptstraße 5), are essential sources of income. The initiative is also among the last organizations offering traditional indigo blueprint for textile products, once typical for the region.

... Mangalica is a pig breed?

Mangalica (wool pig) was once characteristic for the Pannonian basin. This curly breed grows slowly and is best kept outdoors. During the 20th century, Mangalicas were gradually replaced by new, faster growing breeds suitable for intensive pig farms. As a result, the breed became almost extinct by the end of the 1980's. Following a series of political interventions and change in attitude, many farmers started breeding Mangalicas again, stabilizing their numbers in Central Europe by the beginning of the 21st century.

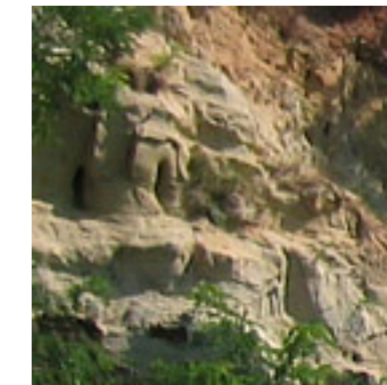
... there is a link between Neusiedl am See and the River Danube?

Maps originating from the 19th century show an entrenchment line between Petronell in the north and the Ruins of Tabor in Neusiedl am See. This line of fortification was created in the early 18th century and is a distinct landscape feature, especially in the area of Parndorf.



... you do not need additional energy to keep your wine cool?

In the northeast of the historic centre of Neusiedl am See, traditional wine cellars form a line in the loess wall marking the boundaries of the Wagram. The layers of soil around these cellars buffer changes in the outside temperature naturally. This means that these cellars have a cooling effect during hot summers on the one hand, and resist temperatures below zero during winter, on the other. As temperature is regulated by the soil, no additional energy input is needed.



... there is a Natural Monument in Neusiedl am See?

In the north of Neusiedl am See, the Plateau of Parndorf ends abruptly at the Wagram resulting in a wall of loess. This geological feature is also a valuable habitat and breeding ground for birds and insects. In 1980, the site was listed as natural monument housing a colony of Sand Martins (*Riparia riparia*) and represents the only Natural Monument of Neusiedl am See.
